Part 1 General

1.1 Insurance

- .1 The Contractor shall, without limiting any of its obligations and liabilities, procure and maintain and pay for the following insurance coverages, at its own expense, with respect to and for the duration of the Contract.
- .2 The Contractor shall be responsible to ensure its Subcontractors, Consultants and Engineers procure and maintain, at their cost, equivalent insurance. The terms of the insurance shall cover the Contractor's insurable obligations under this Contract, including the following minimum insurance coverages:
 - .1 Commercial General Liability insurance, with a minimum limit not less than \$2,000,000 for each occurrence of personal injury, bodily injury (and death) and property damage, including:
 - .1 City of Regina as Additional Insured
 - .2 Non-Owned Automobile Liability
 - .3 Waiver of Subrogation
 - .4 Contractual Liability
 - .5 Broad Form Property Damage
 - .6 Sudden & Accidental Pollution
 - .2 Automobile Liability Insurance covering all motor vehicles owned and non-owned, operated or licensed by Contractor with a minimum bodily injury and property damage limit of \$2,000,000 inclusive;
- .3 The insurance provided by Contractor pursuant to this Contract shall be provided in accordance with the following terms and conditions:
 - .1 All insurance maintained by Contractor will be primary insurance and not contingent or excess of insurance carried by any other party;
 - .2 The Owner shall be added as Additional Insured on all policies indicates.
 - .3 Such policies shall, where appropriate, provide that a thirty (30) day written notice shall be given to Owner prior to any cancellation of any such policy or policies;
 - .4 The Contractor shall provide the Owner with a duly authorized certificate of insurance, in duplicate, within ten (10) days of signing the Contract;
 - .5 Insurance is to be placed with insurers authorized to conduct business in the Province of Saskatchewan with a current A.M. Best's rating of no less than A or better;
 - .6 Subject to the other provisions of the Contract, Contractor shall provide any other insurance which it is required by law to provide, as well and other insurance as may, from time to time, be requested by Owner;
 - .7 Contractor shall be responsible for any deductibles or self-insured retentions;
 - .8 The Contractor agrees, to hold an active employer's account and be in good standing with the Saskatchewan Worker's Compensation Board for the duration of the Contract; and

- .9 Before commencing any Work under the Contract, Contractor shall deliver to the Owner a certificate from the appropriate Workers' Compensation Board showing Contractor has registered and is in good standing with such Board or Commission.
