

Recent inspection by the dealer found signs of weakness in some welds on the angle part of the camper

This trailer is 8' wide, 41' long and when hooked up to a truck, 13' 6" (4.11 meters) high. It has 5 slides, 3 slides work with a Schwintek system and the main diner/fridge/ stove slide is hydraulically powered rack and pinion. There are 6 hydraulic jacks that are long enough to raise the trailers tires off the ground should you need to change a tire or work under the trailer. The hydraulic panel allows you to level the trailer manually or use the auto leveling feature. The two knobs on the bottom of the panel are shut off valves for the main slides. This allows you to close only one slide at a time.

With 405 Sq. Ft. of luxury living with marble counter tops, an island with two sinks and new faucet, Furrion stove with a 3-burner top and oven, High Pointe convection microwave, a Samsung 3 door fridge with ice cube maker and a dining table that expands to comfortably seat 4 adults. The two additional chairs are stored under the king-sized bed. Inside the bedroom closet are the fittings for a washer/dryer set up. A central vacuum has a non powered head that can reach all rugs and also have a floor level slot in the kitchen to sweep dirt into vacuum. The washroom has new sink faucets and the shower has a corner seat with lots of shelves to hold product. The two lounge slides have sofa beds so this unit sleeps 6. The theater chairs have power leg rests facing a 45" Smart Fire TV, sound bar and fireplace. The audio system can be controlled through an app on your phone. There are 3 Smart Fire TV's, the 45" in the lounge, a 32" in the bedroom and a 24" outside on the diner slide. The powered awning is 17' long which covers the exterior speakers.

Two Dometic air conditioners keep the trailer cool. The main temperature control is sensitive to touch so you only need to brush your finger on the face to change settings. If you press on the control, you will break it (I did and it costs to replace it). The main control will operate the furnace and A/C. The bedroom control only operates the bedroom A/C. Temperature reading either Celsius or Fahrenheit. Simple press both up and down arrows at the same time to change the setting. The trailer is also wired for solar panels.

In the utility bay you will see at the top, an outdoor shower. Next down the panel is the winterise intake to distribute the antifreeze. Beside that is a valve lever to open the winterising valve. In the middle is the water intake and beside is a valve to switch to filling the fresh water tank. The bottom intake is for rinsing the black water tank. The valve next to it will cut off the water to the hot water tank. Used to stop putting antifreeze into the hot water tank during winterizing. On the bottom there are the release levers for the black water tank and the washroom grey water tank. The release lever for the kitchen grey water tank is under the fridge/stove slide. On the side wall are the cable TV feed and 2 satellite feeds.

The furnace heats the trailer using 6 ducts, One for the lounge, 2 for the kitchen, one for the washroom, one for the bedroom and the last heats the pass-through storage. The 12-gallon hot water heater is heated either with 110 shoreline power or propane when boondocking.

The big feature of this trailer is the storage space. You have the usual storage in the front with the 2 – 6-volt deep cycle batteries, the usual pass-through storage and the unique 9 1/2 foot roll out storage tray from the back of the trailer. Two side storage bins are on the sides at the back as well. Another feature is the power inverter in the pass-through storage on the ceiling. It converts 12 volts to 110 volts to run the fridge when traveling.

There is a 25' sewer hose stored below the pass-through door and a 15' sewer hose extension in the rear bumper. The trailer has 4 tanks. A black water tank, a grey water tank for the washroom waste, a grey water tank for the kitchen sink and a fresh water tank for boondocking.

New suspension and one year old tires make the ride smooth.
