

Specifications for Acrow Bridge adjacent to Victoria Ave.

For the proponent bidding on the removal and hauling of Acrow bridge adjacent to Victoria Ave, Regina SK. Drive, the City of Regina will require that the following specifications be followed:

1. **Insurance** – the proponent will need to provide proof of insurance. The insurance coverage details are included in the attachment.
2. **Traffic Plan** – if proponent is anticipating restricting or closing any road during removal, the City will provide a traffic plan and accommodations. Proponent must give one week notice for request of traffic plan.
3. **Trucking permits** - proponent is to acquire over-dimensional move permit from City of Regina and Saskatchewan trucking permit from SGI and hauling permits from any other municipality the load will be passing through onto final destination.
4. **Security** – Proponent is to ensure that the site is left safe and secure at all times. City is not responsible for security of the site or any equipment left on site.
5. **Safety plan** – If requested, the proponent must submit a site safety plan.
6. **OH&S Regulations** – proponent is to ensure that all OH&S regulations are followed and that they keep a copy of the regulations on site.
7. **Fall Arrest** – proponent is responsible for all fall arrest training. If requested, proponent is to provide fall arrest training certificates.
8. **Utilities** – The proponent is responsible for locating any utilities that may be affected by their activities Any damage to utilities is the responsibility of the proponent.
9. **Operator certificates** – if requested, the proponent is to provide all operator certificates.
10. **Site Condition** – once all work is complete, proponent is to ensure that site is left in good condition. Site must be clear of any material or debris that the proponent is responsible for and that any ground disturbed by their activities is restored to original condition
11. **Deposit** – the proponent will be required to provide a \$5,000 deposit. This money will be refunded once the site is completely cleaned to the satisfaction of the City of Regina.
12. **Liability** – The city assumes no liability or responsibility for bridge after sale. The proponent is responsible for safely removing bridge from site and for reinstalling for intended purpose.
